Invest in B4RN

Help bring 1,000Mbps Broadband to North Tyne and Redesdale

- You each have the opportunity to invest in order to help fund the scheme, if you wish to.
- The core of every community's investment is made up of shares (NB: you do not have to invest to get a B4RN connection).
- Shares must be held for a minimum 3 years (then they can be withdrawn by the shareholder) and have an attractive return (currently 5% p.a.).
- Invest £1,500 and your connection fee (worth £150) is waived.
- You can invest more. For every £1,500, another person can be connected for free.
- Investment makes you a member. You can add to your shareholding at any time.

The B4RN Community Benefit Society aims to:

- 1. Provide high speed broadband to rural premises, especially in those areas poorly served by other suppliers;
- 2. Promote the take up of broadband, the Internet and the use of ICT generally in previously digitally disadvantaged areas;
- 3. Give a chance for the public-spirited to contribute financially to the community - for social dividend, rather than personal reward.
